












Day 1-2:

New Delhi



Chandigarh




Shimla


Sarahan


Sangla

Sangla in the Baspa Valley also known as Sangla Valley, located in the Kinnaur district of Himachal Pradesh. It is the Scenic town with Verdant forests of pine trees, majestic Himalayan mountains, Baspa River flowing through the valley.and vibrant orchards of apples and apricots. Some popular places to visit here are Baspa River, Kamru Fort, Tibetan Wood Carving Center and Bering Nag Temple. After the sight seeing of Raksham and Chitkul (the last village on the border of India and China) village in Sangla we will proceed to our next destination Kalpa.


Kalpa is a small village in the Sutlej river valley in the Kinnaur District of Himachal Pradesh, Northern India. It is well known for its Apple Orchards. The famous attractions of Kalpa which we are going to visit are:-SUICIDE POINT, BASTERI VILLAGE, CHAKKA & RECKONG PEO.



Day 10-11:

Nako

After reaching Nako we will visit the **OLD MONASTERY** OF POOH VILLAGE. NAKO LAKE is the main tourist attraction in the Nako valley. The lake has become famous for the many bird-sounds that can be heard in the area because of this phenomenon. Other famous places to visit in Nako village are NAKO MONASTERY, NAKO GOMPA and SACRED LAKE.




It is the day for **TABO SIGHT SEEING**. We will Visit the monastery of tabo. Tabo Monastery is located in the Tabo village of Spiti Valley, Himachal Pradesh. Tabo is noted for being the oldest continuously operating Buddhist enclave in both India and the Himalayas. One can also visit the **CAVES OF THE TABO VILLAGE** where the lama has sat for meditations.











Day -13:

Kaza

Tabo to Kaza. (90 kms. 4hrs) Kaza is a town and the subdivisional headquarters of the remote Spiti Valley in the western Himalayas in the Lahaul and Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh. Kaza is known for its colourful festivals and the ancient Sakya Tangyud Monastery. It is also popular with tourists and adventure seekers during the period of June, July and August and September because of its central location and connections to the rest of the valley. The famous places of interest are:- KAZA MONASTERY, SAKA TANGYUD MONASTERY & KOMIC WORLD'S HIGHEST VILLAGE.



Day -14:

Kibber

Kibber aka Kyibar village rests high in the Spiti Valley in Himachal Pradesh at an altitude of 14200 ft. It is famous for several things –a monastery, **KIBBER WILDLIFE SANCTUARY**, **the HIGHEST POST OFFICE IN THE WORLD**, and as a destination with the highest motorable road. **CHICHAM BRIDGE** which is the world's highest suspension bridge , which connects kibber village with the chincham village in the spiti valley.



Manali

A gift of the Himalayas to the world, Manali is a beautiful township nestled in the Beas River valley. Manali is a town in the Indian state of Himachal Pradesh. It is a place known for its cool climate and snow-capped mountains, offering respite to tourists escaping scorching heat of the plains. Top sights of manali are:- HADIMBA DEVI TEMPLE, MALL ROAD, JOGINI FALLS. You can do MOUNTAIN TREKKING, PARAGLIDING, SOLANG VALLEY SKIING etc.
